Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM), Music and Innovation Scholarships for High School Seniors from Carlsbad Unified School District

Carlsbad Educational Foundation (CEF) scholarships are intended to encourage students to pursue careers in their selected college fields. Fifteen \$1,000 scholarships are available to high school seniors in the Carlsbad Unified School District who are pursuing secondary education with a two-year or four-year college or university and have been involved in a program funded by CEF. Two of the scholarships, sponsored by ViaSat, will be awarded specifically to students who have participated in Science Olympiad and five of the scholarships will be designated specifically to need-based applicants.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

1. High school senior attending a Carlsbad Unified School District high school.
2. Minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 (copy of student's unofficial transcript is required).
3. Plan to attend a two-year or four-year college or university in the U.S.
4. Two letters of recommendation. Letters should be related to a program supported by CEF that impacted your school experience. One letter must be from a teacher/instructor, the second from a supervisor, youth leader, or other adult.
5. One-page essay describing your educational plan and how participation in a program supported by CEF has impacted your educational goals (see page 2 for essay details and a list of these programs).
6. FAFSA results (SAR required only if you would like to be considered for need-based assistance).
7. Application, additional documents and interview sign-up must be received by **April 20, 2020**.
8. All applicants may be required to complete an interview with the scholarship committee.

You should also consider and include the following topics in your essay:

- What is your field of study and why did you choose it?
- Awards, honors, and/or merits received during high school.
- Why do you believe you deserve to receive this scholarship?
- Is there anything else you would like the committee to know?
