On behalf of the board and staff of the Carlsbad Educational Foundation (CEF), we are pleased to share this annual report with the community.

The 2012 – 2013 fiscal year marked our 30th year as a local education foundation serving Carlsbad and enriching the education of its students. We are proud of the impact we are making by raising nearly \$680,000 for programs that promote educational excellence for more than 11,000 students in the Carlsbad Unified School District.

Our theme for this year's annual report, "Collaboration," is truly one of the major keys to our success. Whether partnering with Carlsbad-based companies or local PTAs, harnessing the wisdom of volunteer committees or coordinating the execution of new programs with colleagues at Carlsbad Unified School District, CEF accomplishes exponentially more by working closely with others to achieve our mission.

From kindergarten through high school seniors, we run direct-service programs and grant funds to the district that create new and innovative educational opportunities. Many, if not all, of CEF's funded programs simply would not exist without private support. Thanks to strong community involvement, CEF continues to attract funders who are helping us elevate education in our schools while closing the gaps caused by ongoing state and federal budget cuts. Together, we're making a big difference in the lives of our students!

Working closely with a variety of community partners, business leaders, community members, elected officials, school administrators and philanthropists, as well as parents and volunteers—CEF successfully harnesses the generosity of the Carlsbad community and translates it into tangible programs that make a real impact on the education of our students.

For example, CEF funds a science lab Teacher's Assistant at the high school along with "traveling" science lab teachers for 4th and 5th graders. These credentialed teachers play a pivotal role in bringing science to life for our students through hands-on coursework.

Similarly, CEF continues to be a strong advocate for the arts with continued funding for all K-5 music teachers as well as first-time funding for middle and high school music programs. During the current school year, funds now will be available to band, choir, and orchestra to augment specialist coaches and instrument repairs.

In addition to new and expanded areas of support, we remain dedicated to other grant-funded programs, including FIRST LEGO League and FIRST Tech Challenge Robotics, Science Olympiad, BizTown, My Access, and many more. We are able to retain many of these important programs, thanks to the shared commitment of our corporate partners and, in part, to funds raised through our direct-service programs, such as Kids' Care, After-School Enrichment, Summer Enrichment, and High School Summer Academy.

We look forward to further collaboration with our many community partners and supporters, while encouraging those who aren't involved with CEF yet to get to know us and the students, teachers, and schools that benefit from our steadfast commitment to educational excellence.

EDUCATIONAL IMPACT 2012 - 2013

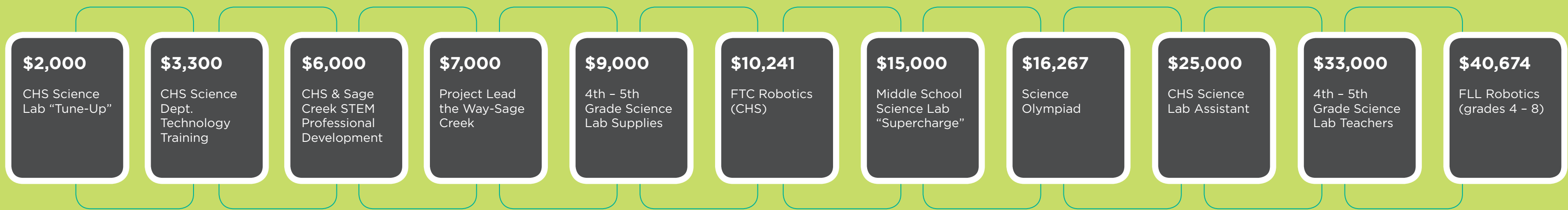
Due to funding cuts, the Carlsbad Unified School District now ranks last out of all 42 school districts in San Diego County in per-pupil funding for public education. The work of the Carlsbad Educational Foundation is more critical than ever in supporting our local students.

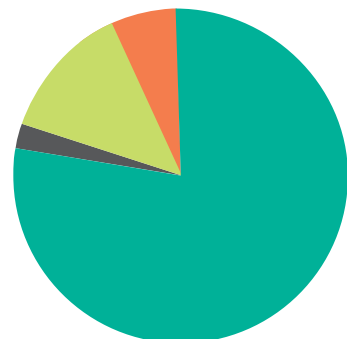

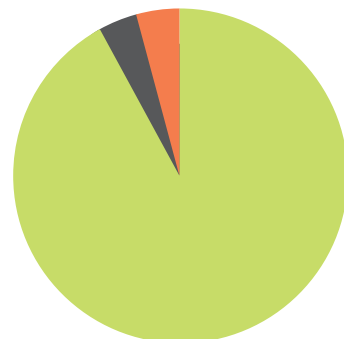

Through regular program evaluations of students, parents and teachers, we know our programs make a difference. Below are a few highlights from recent surveys:

HANDS-ON SCIENCE:

FIRST LEGO League (FLL) Robotics and Science Olympiad:

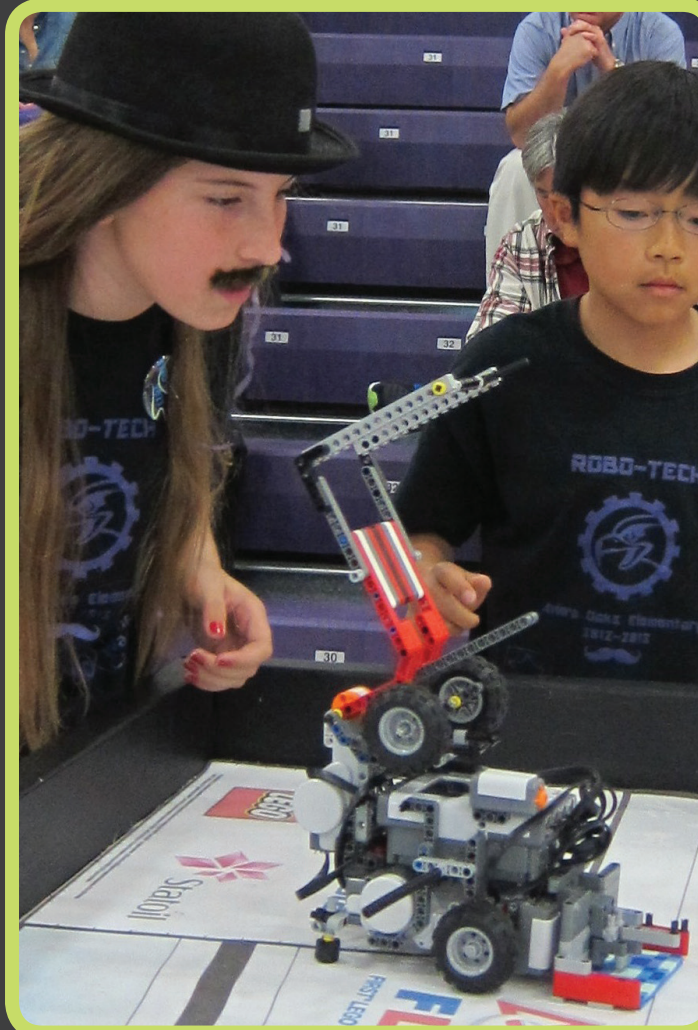
- >> 100% of students surveyed for FLL and Science Olympiad plan to take advanced math or science classes in high school
- >> 96% of those polled said these programs increased their interest in science and technology
- >> 88% of survey respondents said FLL increased their confidence in public speaking
- >> 88% of those polled said they may consider a career in programming, technology, medicine or another science related career
- >> 68% of FLL survey respondents said FLL increased their interest in school in general

In addition, science department teachers at Carlsbad High School shared the following about the newly funded science lab Teacher's Assistant:

- >> 100% of those polled agreed this new program allows teachers to incorporate more lab activities; 90% shared that it offers significant support to existing teachers, 80% believe it adds more time for students to conduct labs and 90% noted this additional resource enhances student scientific knowledge by better supporting teachers.

EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION AND MUSIC:

- >> Most English teachers found the computer-based MY ACCESS writing assistance program very useful, sharing that it improved students' overall writing abilities (93%) while also increasing the volume of the writing projects students complete (86%).
- >> K-5 music teachers shared they believe that weekly music is valuable to our 5,000 elementary school students by building self-confidence, collaboration, math, and reading skills.

Weekly classes are taught by credentialed teachers or specialists in their fields designed specifically to inspire and provide additional educational enrichment opportunities to students in kindergarten thru eighth grade in the areas of science, music, technology and the arts.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM FOR K-8 STUDENTS

Operating since 1990 at every CUSD elementary school, CEF's CEF operates a fun and enriching series of half-day camps each June-July, offering 60 programs designed specifically to inspire and teach students ages 5 to 14 in the areas of science, music, technology and the arts.

CEF SUMMER ACADEMY FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

CEF offers summer classes for advancement credit for students entering grades 9 through 12 in Carlsbad and surrounding school districts. The CEF Summer Academy program offers a variety of courses during an intensive 3 to 6 week session during the months of June and July.
